



# Will County Health Department H1N1 Vaccine Clinic Schedule



## The Will County Health Department

will begin dispensing H1N1 flu vaccine beginning on October 28, 2009. If you live or work in Will County, this vaccine will be administered to you and your family at no cost. Because of the limited nationwide supply, the Health Department recommends this vaccine initially for certain priority groups:

- **Pregnant women**
- **Anyone who cares for children younger than 6 months of age**
- **Young people between the ages of 6 months and 24 years**
- **People younger than 64 years of age with chronic medical conditions such as asthma, diabetes, or heart disease**
